Aufberg 1110 with its two exclusive apartments is located in the midst of the High Tauern region with a magnificent view of the mountains. The house pays tribute to its neighbor, yet remains independent. Together they create a special venue on the mountain.

The simple structure seems to be naturally carved out of the rock with its roof reflecting the same steep slope. The house is entirely made out of wood, rendering it ecological and sustainable. The raw larch wood cladding allows the house to age with dignity while also giving it a warm atmosphere on the inside and outside.

The interior is unexpectedly spacious. Two apartments with galleries

are located at different heights. At the same time, the windows frame the view of the landscape and create a flowing transition between indoors and outdoors. The open fireplace and the warm larch wood create a protective chalet atmosphere that is very comforting.
